

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Austin Burt on 9/2/1851. Original bearing trees:

Sugar 8" S.51° E. 27 links (17.82') Sugar 14" N.29° W. 28 links (18.48')

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I restored the corner position at record bearing and distance from the remains of the two original bearing trees. The first is a series of root holes with portions of badly decayed Sugar Maple wood. The second one is now a windthrown stump hole.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a $2^n \times 30^n$ aluminum pipe monument with a $3.1/4^n$ stamped aluminum cap and the Following new B.T.s (all measurements taken to a nail in side of tree):
