Drahn, RLS 21564 on 6/9/86 from the stump holes of the 1st, 2nd, and 4th B.T.s and from the decayed stump of the 3rd B.T. and from retracement measurement east and south to natural feature ties and recovered corners. He set a 2" X 3' iron pipe monument with a 3" stamped brass cap and the following new B.T.s:
