Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Original corner established by Austin Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor on August 27, 1847. Original bearing trees: Y. Birch 14" S.84°W. 23 links (15.18 feet) 12" Y. Birch N.41°E. 33 links (21.78 feet) No record of subsequent corner restoration found. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner: Restored corner at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees. The first is now a series of large yellow birch roots that have been disturbed by a log decking area. The second one is now a 20-24" decayed yellow birch stump. Original corner location lays within 2.1 feet of a N-S mathematical analysis of over five miles of range line between ranges 44 and 45 West, Townships 45 and 46 North. C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: At the corner position I set a 3/4" outside diameter by 6 foot long aluminum rod monument with a 3" cast aluminum cap, stamped to read T.45-46N., R.44-45W.; S-31, S-6, S-1, S-36; 1993; R.L.S. 21564. From which I have established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees: 10" Hemlock N.02°W. 31.70 feet 10" Hemlock N.76°E. 46.88 feet 13" S.12°W.
