

On October 20, 1970, Donald D. Lappal, RLS, restored corner position at record bearing and distance from the stump hole of the two original bearing trees. Corner position verified further by measurement to recoverable record natural features and record line tree. He set a 2½" I.pipe with 3" bronze cap and new B.T. - 10" Elm- N12°W- 39.1'; 5" R. Maple- N54°E- 17.5'; 7" Elm- S 72°W- 13.8'. Corner recorded in USFS liber, Z-11 on Augustr10; 1972.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Recovered the monument as described and I bearing tree and stump hole of 10" Elm N 120 W 39.1'. I updated the corner monument and accessories as noted below to state and county specification.
