

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by Austin Burt on 8/31/1847. Original B.T.s --- Y. Birch 18" S.34 E. 35 links (23.10') --- Cedar 12" N.66 W. 35 links (23.10') --- R.G. Campbell, on 7/26/35 recovered both BT's still scribed and placed a location poster on the south side of a 16" Black Ash.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Restored corner position at record bearing and distance from the remains of the two original BT's. The first one is a badly decayed 20-22" Yellow Birch stump. The second one is now a downed, badly decayed 14-18" Cedar with evidence of the GLO blaze overgrowth still present.

Campbell's tag tree is now a broken 20-24" Black Ash stub bearing N.72 W. 9.0' from the original corner location. Unable to find his location poster.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
