A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original B.T.s --- Cedar Corner established by John Burt on 9/1/1847. 10" S.40 E. 13 links (8.58') --- Spruce 6" N.24 W. 14 links (9.24') ---

R. Burke & J. Peryam, timber cruisers, recovered this location in Feb. 1955. They reported a USFS Location Poster and recovered a leaning 12" Cedar signed by Wade Weston, on which he wrote "B T". 1955 notes state that work on B.T. was "very old".

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Restored corner position at record bearing and distance from the remains of the two original B.T.s. The first, very badly decayed 14-16" Cedar with portions of the blaze overgrowth and face blaze still evident. second on is now an extremely badly decayed 10-12" Spruce stump. The Cedar 8" line tree 0.20 chains (13.20') south, is now a large windthrown depression.

Recovered a 1935 era USFS Location Poster on a 8" Balsam stub bearing N.49 E., 8.4' from the original corner location.
