

Drahn that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by John Burt on 8/31/1847. Original bearing trees:

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Spruce	12"	N.80°E.	80 links	(52.80')
Spruce	8"	N.36° W.	36 links	(23.76')
Spruce	14"	5.49° W.	38 links	(25.08')
Soruce	12"	S.11° E.	43 links	(28.381)

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Corner position restored at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees. Corner area is in a large open swamp grass meadow. As mature trees die and fall over they provide a solid base for tag alder clumps to take root on. The only alder clumps observed in the area are on these downed trees. No evidence of the original Spruce wood remains, only a clump of alder that had taken root on them. Also observed was an absents of grass hummocks where the trees root system had been uplifted. The 0.50 chain distance east to "Brook 2 lks. SW", the 2.10 chain distance south to "Stream 2 lks. SW" and the 1.50 chain distance west to "Leave swamp, N&S" are all in accord with the field notes of the original Government survey.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 3/4" X 4' long solid aluminum rod with a 3 1/4" stamped aluminum cap and the following new bearing objects.
