



B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Corner position restored at record bearing and distance from the remains of the two original B.T.s. The first is a 16-20" Hemlock stump, decayed to near ground level. The second one in now a large deep stump hole with small portions of the major Hemlock roots and Hemlock knots.

A Cedar post and an iron pipe set by Gogebic County Forestry Commission bears N.40 W., 25.9 feet from the original corner location.
