5. Private Claims

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:


(K-4) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 11 & 12, T46N, R47W

I found no record of subsequent restoration.





B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. North – South Van Buskirk Road now runs over area of corner. I created a position for the ¼ corner at the intersection of centerline of Van Buskirk Road and the extension of a very old fence to the West. This position works well with section corners to the North and South. After consulting John Garske, P.S., who has done extensive remonumentation work in this area, I accepted this position as the true ¼ corner position.

C. Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" iron pin with a 3" diameter bronze cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION: T46N, R47W; ¼; S. 11, S. 12; 1999; P.S. 37273. A reference monument was also set to the Northeast, a 2 ½" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to indicate that the ¼ corner is S 50°W, 42.79'. Corner falls in centerline of Road, 32' North of a driveway. Ties to the Corner:
