

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original survey by Wm. A. Burt on August 10, 1848. Set a Hemlock Post. Original Bearing Trees; Hemlock 16"- N 27°W-45 links; Lynn 14"- N 38°E-14 links.

John P. Goss in 1983 using MDOT witnesses set a 1 inch iron rebar and recorded this corner in Liber 2 pages 308 and 309 of Gogebic County Land Corners; 8" Maple- N 60°E- 11.28'; 4" Maple- S 40°W- 13.78'; 9" Maple- N 29°W- 33.46'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found the 1 inch iron rebar marking the corner position and it checked with witnesses in John P. Goss certificate. I updated the corner monument and accessories as noted below to state and county specifications.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Over the lineh iron rebar I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " aluminum cap stamped: County Remonumentation; 1/4; S-6; S-31; T.47-48 N.; R.42 W.; 1995; P.S. 23509. I established the following bearing trees and reference objects.
