Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a 4" x 4" square post with scribing. Post found in standing water. Also found a cedar bearing tree with tag N88°W, 5.0 feet.

Established the corner by single proportionatal measurement, using the found meander corner and found section corner as noted on plat of Lake Gogebic East Shores recorded in 1964. The corner position is approximtely 0.8' south of the found wooden post.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I updated the corner position to state and county specifications by setting a 1-4 foot section of 3/4" aluminum swamp rod with a 3/4" aluminum cap stamped: County Remonumentation; 1/4; S-33; S-4; T48N, T47N, R42W; 1994; RLS 28410. I established the following bearing trees and reference objects: 3" ash - N33°E, 5.28 feet; 6" balsam fir - N42°W, 19.90 feet; 8" ash - S42°W, 18.04 feet; 6 foot steel rail with sign - S54 E, 1.85 feet.
