1990 survey by John R. Garske found 1" drill rod and witnessed 6" ash - N30°W, 7.12 feet; 10" ash - S76°E, 7.04 feet; 7" ash - S60°W, 6.09 feet. Corner checks against 1964 plat as noted above.
