1961 - Neil Sperhake, RLS 7876, surveyor for Kimberly Clark restored the corner and set a 4"

diameter aluminum cap on a 1" diameter iron pipe at the corner. Bearing trees: 12" maple - N15°W - 25.5 feet 6" maple - S20'E - 21.6 feet

1969 - Don Lappala, RLS 12585 - Found Sperhake's corner in good condition and recorded it on

3/31/69, Liber 1, pg. 89. Bearing trees are same as above.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

On June 17, 1990 - I found the Sperhake and Lappala bearing trees but the corner monument was destroyed. I reset the monument with a 2 1/2" diameter x 30" long aluminum pipe with a stamped 3" diameter aluminum cap and established three new B.T.'s:

6" maple - S20'E - 21.55 feet 12" maple - N15"W - 25.45 feet 6" maple - S50'W - 20.14 feet

On November 3, 1994, I found the monument and bearing trees to be in good condition and I brought the corner up to county specs as noted below.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the pos

Found the 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 3" aluminum cap stamped: 1/4 cor.; S-23; S-26; T47N, R42W; 1990; RLS 28410. Bearing trees and reference objects:

> 6" maple - S20°E - 21.55 feet (existing)
> 12" maple - N15°W - 25.45 feet (existing)
> 6" maple - S50°W - 20.14 feet (existing) Steel sign post - Due East - 1.59 feet
