Corner established by William Burt in 1848. Original B.T.s --- Maple 6" N.45 E. 8 links (5.28') --- Hemlock 12" S.50 W. 30 links (19.80') ---

Corner restored by Donald D. Lappala, RLS 12585, on 9/28/70 by retracement measurement to recovered natural feature ties and line trees. He set a 2½" by 5' iron pipe with a 3" stamped brass cap and the following new bearing trees: --- Sugar Maple 7" (dead) N.51 E. 113.9' --- Red Maple 7" (8") N.89 E. (N.85 E.) 115.1' (115.12') --- Sugar Maple 9" (13") S.12 W. (S.13 W.) 69.2' (68.88' slope distance) ---

Corner recorded in Gogebic County in USFS Liber, Page P-5 on 8/10/72.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Act 74 research form on file with Gogebic County records.
