Drahn in a field survey on May 6, 19 96. do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt in 1848. Original B.T.s --- Y. Birch 6"

S.70 W.,32 links (21.12') --- Fir 8" N.50 E., 15 links (9.90').

Corner restored by Donald D. Lappala, RLS 12585 from the stump remains of the two original bearing trees and from natural feature ties north. He set a 2" by 5' iron pipe with a 3" stamped brass cap and the following new bearing objects: --- X chiseld on top of 36" x 18" x 12" boulder S.02 E. (S.02 E.) 14.5' (14.5') --- 8" (9") Elm (dead) S.37 W. (S.38 W.) 30.3' --- 10" (14") Elm (dead) S.85 W. (S.85 W.) 36.1' (36.1').

Corner recorded in Gogebic County in USFS Liber, Page T-5 on 5/27/70.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
Act 74 research form on file with Gogebic County records.

Recovered the monument as described and the bearing objects as noted in parentheses above. No evidence remains of the original bearing trees.

U.S. Forest Service maintained this corner on 12/9/85 and established the following new bearing tree.
