I set a mathematical point at the proportional position from which to search and found no evidence of the original bearing trees. The corner location falls on an old blue painted line. A small post bears N30°W, 30°± from our position. I set the corner at the math point due to a lack of any other evidence to position the corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a 2 1/2" x 30" long aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter tablet stamped to read: 1/4 corner, S-11, S-12, T47N, R44W, 1992; RLS 28410. Established the following bearing trees and/or reference objects:
