Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I reestablished the corner at the center line intersection of a southerly and westerly trail with a northerly fence line. The fence line running north is 40 to 50 years old. This corner position is consistent with natural feature ties and was established after a diligent search failed to find any original or subsequent evidence of the corner position. Measurements to known corner positions

east and south were used to verify this position.
