Corner position was marked by an iron pipe for over 40 years but was destroyed by gas line construction. Local long time area resident, Charles Drier, pointed out correct location of corner position to us as he knew it to exist. The corner falls at the intersection of a southerly and westerly ancient fence line on the south side of Drier Road. This position is consistent with natural feature ties and was used and accepted at this location prior to being destroyed.
