Burt, D.S., corner was set on north line, T47N, R46W intersecting range line 1.75 chains south of post and set cedar post corner of T47 and 48N between R46 and 47W. Original bearing trees: 18" hemlock S38°W, 32 links; 14" Y. birch S37'E, 33 links.
 - Survey on March 4, 1991, by John R. Garske, RLS 28410, set 1/4 corner by single proportional measurement on the range line in accordance with the original government field notes. No original evidence of the corner position now remains. The corner fall 8 feet ± west of the centerline of the existing gravel county road (Look Out Lane) opposite a rock wall fence to the west and a tree line to the east.
