B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I established the corner in the centerline of Hill Avenue opposite a fence line funning south. This position checks with the Plat of Hill Estates Addition recorded in 1926, showing a distance of 1314.00 feet from the W 1/16 to the monumented one-quarter corner of Sections 16 and 21. We used a doubled distance of 2628.00 to check the old fence and set the corner accordingly. GLO Creek calls north and west are consistent with this location. An ancient fence line also runs west, starting approximately 700' west of our corner running all the way to the monumented 1/4 corner. OF MICE
