B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a P.K. nail in the middle of the intersection at the correct corner position. I updated the corner position and accessories as noted below to bring it up to county and state specifications.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I replaced the P.K. nail with a 2 1/2" brass cap with a 1 1/2" stem set in anchoring cement 2" below the surface of the pavement and stamped: S-9, S-10, S-15, S-16, T47N, R46W, 1994, RLS 28410. I established the following bearing trees and reference objects: Reference monument consisting of a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" aluminum cap stamped to indicate the corner position - N40°W, 44.05 feet with a steel sign post 1.53 feet away; P. pole - N45°W, 1541 feet; P. pole - N18°E, 52.57 feet; hydrant - N51°E, 40.68 feet.
