A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original survey by Austin Burt, D.S. in 1851. He set a wood post from which:

Sugar 6"

S48°W 1'5links

Sugar 8"

N75°E 35 links

1.5 chains west - "run"

2.00 chains west - S.E. side of knob

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

At the corner location I found a 1 1/4" "O.D. iron pipe at the intersection of ancient fence lines running east-west and south. I measured 33 feet west to a small drainage course and 132 feet west to side of knob which checks extremely good with GLO calls noted above. I accepted the iron pipe at the fence intersection as the best evidence of the original corner position.
