Garske _ in a field survey on 19 do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

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Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Survey by William Ives on August 30, 1848. Set wood post from which a 4" fir bears N70°E - 5 links and a 8" Y. birch bears \$70°W - 4 links.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence found. A P.K. nail was found at corner position which has been used and accepted historically at the center line/center line intersection of Nylund and Junet Roads by local residents, the County Road Commission and local surveyors. I am accepting this position as being

the most probable location of the true one-quarter corner.

Set an 8" cotton gin spike (1/2" diameter case hardened steel tapered to a point) at center line. Center line of Junet Road and Nylund Road. Reference monument - N46°W - 45.19 feet. Set 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum County Monument with a 3 1/2" stamped aluminum cap - steel sign post - 1.77 feet.
