Two reference monuments, 2 1/2" x 30" long aluminum monuments with 3 1/2" diameter aluminum caps stamped to identify the R.M.'s and corner location as follows:

1-Reference monument S52°W - 31.70 feet, 1.11 feet to steel sign post

2-Reference monument - N40°W - 38.60 feet, 1.00 feet to steel sign post

3-8" basswood - N40°E - 52.65 feet

4-12" basswood in a clump - S89°E - 43.00 feet
