A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded

Original survey by William Ives, D.S., in 1848. Set wood post. Original bearing trees: Spruce 12" - S58°W, 5 links; Spruce 10" - N46°E, 7 links.

The one-quarter corner position was set by John R. Garske, RLS 28410, in February 1983 using existing evidence and retracement measurements and consists of a P.K. nail in the road centerline. The corner is recorded in liber 2 of land corners P. 296. Accessories: west trunk of twin 14" birch - N47°W, 57.50'. Corner post - S87°E, 33.00'; Poplar 8" - S85°W, 34.54'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I checked a found P.K. nail at the one-quarter corner position from witnesses on my previous recordation certificate and updated the corner as noted below to bring it up to county and state specifications.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Using the existing P.K. nail at the one-quarter corner location, I established the following reference objects: Two reference monuments consisting of a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap stamped to indicate the corner position as follows: R.M. #1-S36*W, 49.15 feet - with steel sign post 1.73 feet away; R.M. #2-S69*E, 40.48 feet - with steel sign post 2.04 feet away; existing poplar 10" - S85*W, 34.54 feet; W. birch 6" - S38*E, 60.04 feet.
