The corner position was found by John P. Goss, RLS 23509 in September of 1981 consisting of a concrete monument in the road surface set by U.S.D.A. Farm Security Commission in 1938. He recorded the corner in Liber 2 of land corners, P. 126. Accessories: Elm 6" - N56°E, 62.60 feet; P. pole - S31°E, 54.03 feet; Maple 6" - S22°W, 69.15 feet.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a P.K. nail marking the corner position which checks with Goss's witnesses in his certificate. I updated the corner as noted below to bring it up to county and state specifications.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I replaced the found P.K. nail with a 2 1/2" brass cap with a 2" stem set in anchoring cement. Cap is stamped S-1, S-2, S-11, S-12, T47N, R47W, 1994, RLS 28410. I established the following bearing trees and reference objects: A reference monument consisting of a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" aluminum cap stamped to indicate the corner position a follows: R.M. - N61°E, 59.75 feet with a steel sign post 1.33 feet away; P. pole - S26°E, 53.97 feet; Clump of three Smaples 8" - S23°W, 69.17 feet; Aspen 10" - N49°W, 54.04 feet.
