Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original survey by William Ives in 1848. Set wooden post. Original bearing trees: Cedar 12" -S88°W, 37 links; Cedar 14" - N73°E, 30 links.

The corner position was found by John R. Garske, RLS 28410 in February 1983 consisting of a 1/2" iron rod set in concrete. The corner is recorded in liber 2 of land corners P. 304-305. Accessories: top of hydrant - N27°E - 58.91'; P. Pole - N57°E - 33.51'; P. Pole - S43°W -47.88'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a 1/2" iron rod set in concrete marking the corner location which checks with witnesses from my previous recordation certificate and updated the corner as noted below to bring it up to county and state specifications.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Using the existing iron rod at the corner location, I established the following reference objects: Two reference monuments consisting of a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap stamped to indicate the corner position as follows: R.M. #1 - N38°W - 55.28 feet - with steel sign post 1.64 feet away; R.M. #2 - S35°E - 48.97 feet - with steel sign post 1.64 feet away; existing top of hydrant - N27°E - 58.91 feet; existing P. Pole - N57°E - 33.51 feet.
