The corner position was found by Ewart C., RLS 15408, in July of 1977 marked by a 5/8" diameter solid steel drill rod. He recorded the corner in Liber 1 of corners, page 345 and 346.

Accessories: 3" cherry - S60°E - 72.93 feet; 8" Apple - S07°W - 109.96 feet; N.E. Tower Leg - S56°W - 53.19 feet.

Corner recorded by John Garske, 8/19/94, L5, p 89. Set a standard 2 1/2" dia. x 30" long aluminum monument. Ties: 6" cherry -S57°E - 72.93 feet; 4" cherry - N14°E - 119.42 feet; 6" pine - N23°W - 53.87 feet; N.W. Tower Leg - S59°W - 53.19 feet.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

The monument I set in 1994 had been destroyed along with two bearing trees, apparently due to road construction by Keweenaw Lands into their new log yard. I reset the corner from the remaining corner ties and set a witness corner, 80.00 feet south of the section corner on the section line common to Sections 23 and 24. The corner now falls in the gravel roadway, so I set a subsurface monument consisting of a 5/8" dia. x 30" long iron rod with a stamped 3" aluminum cap approximately 4" below the gravel road surface.
