Corner established by Austin Burt on September 7, 1848. Original B.T.s --Sugar 8" S.34 E. 13 links (8.58') --- Sugar 6" N.87 W. 29 links (19.14')--Corner restored by Donald D. Lappala, RLS 12585 on 9/6/72 from the live
B.T. at S.34 E. and the stump hole of the second B.T. He set a 2" dia.
iron pipe with a 3" stamped brass cap and the following new bearing trees:
--- 3" (5") Sugar Maple N.08 E. (N.07 E.) 9.7' (9.59') --- 10" (13") Yellow
Birch S.16 E. (S.13 E.) 54.2' (54.08') --- 6" (9") Sugar Maple S.89 W.
(N.86 W.) 25.1' (25.02') --- Metal sign post N.22 W. (N.19 W.) 2.2' (2.2')--Corner recorded in Gogebic County in USFS Liber, Page R-15 on 12/9/74.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Act 74 research form on file with Gogebic County records.

Recovered the monument as described and the bearing objects as noted in parentheses above. The first original B.T. is now a live 27" Sugar Maple with GLO blazes. Only a depression remains from the second GLO B.T.
