

Drahn in a field survey on July 28x1900 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by John Burt on 9/10/1847. Original B.T.s: (16.50) 25 links 18" S.03 W. (5.94) Lynn N.45 E. 9 links 24" Lynn

John F. Meredith, on 4/17/35 recovered two blazed Maples at this corner and placed a location poster on the north side of a 10" Maple. The approximate corner lay N.67 E. 6 ft.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I restored the corner position at record bearing and distance from the windthrow stump holes of the two original bearing trees. Merediths' tag tree is now a badly decayed 12-14" windthrown Sugar Maple bearing West, 3.5ft. A 1/2" iron pipe set by Gogebic County Forestry Comm. bears S.37 E. 6.93' from the original corner position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 30" long aluminum pipe with a 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " stammer aluminum cap and the following new bearing trees: 20.17' N.26 W. 12" Sugar Maple 14.76' 11" S.89 E. Sugar Maple 17.13' S.27 E. 13" Basswood
