

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I restored the corner position at record bearing and distance from the remains B.T.s. The first is a 20-30" Hemlock stump decayed to The second on is now a large series of root holes with of the two original B.T.s. near ground level. Hemlock bark and fragments of Hemlock wood. A downed picket and a 7" Cedar stub, squared for the corner bears S.80 W., 20.8 feet from the original corner location.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 3/4" X 4' solid aluminum marsh rod with
