

Restored corner position at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original Cedar bearing tree. It is now a 16-20" decayed Cedar stump, broken up by logging operations. No evidence remains of the original Spruce bearing tree. A very old downed 6" Cedar, squared for the corner bears N.78° E. 9.71 from the original corner location. An 18" Cedar squared for the corner by L.W. Verch on 10/83 bears N.86° E. 12.5' from the original corner location.
