I found a 2 inch iron pipe at the corner location which I found by using the 1925 C & NW R.R. ties. 5 feet North of the pipe is a 10" Maple with a rusted and Folded corner tag somewhat grown in to the tree. No occupation lines or any other B.T.'s could be found. This corner checks well with the old R.R. plans and is \$00°-04'-15"W - 2633.95' of the Northeast corner of Section 34. (Research on file) C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: I set a 5/8" x 30" rebar with a stamped 3/4" aluminum cap inside the iron pipe I found and grouted it in with quickcrete from which I established: B.Ash N67°E 12.06 feet B.Ash 5" SØ3°W 8.27 feet Maple 10 N75°W 18.97 feet Cedar NØ4°W 29.38 feet Steel sign post NWIU 1.42 feet
