A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original survey by William A. Burt, D.S., in 1847. Set elm post. Original bearing trees: Sugar 8" - N27°E, 14 links; Sugar 8" - N13°W, 26 links.

The corner position was found by John P. Goss, RLS 23509, in June 1977 consisting of a concrete monument set in 1938 by the U.S. Department of Agriculture Farm Security Administration in 1938. He set a P.K. nail at the corner position and recorded the corner in Liber 1 of Land Corners, P. 379. Accessories: P. pole - N-29°W, 24.96 feet; Elm 11" - S62°W, 58.18 feet; N. pine 14" - N58°E, 61.24 feet.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a P.K. nail marking the corner position which checks with the witnesses in the certificate. I updated the corner as noted below to bring it up to county and state specifications.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I replaced the found P.K. nail with a 2 1/2" brass cap with a 2" stem set in anchoring cement 1 1/2" below pavement. Cap is stamped S-35, S-2, T47-48N, R47W, 1/4, 1994, RLS 28410. I established the following bearing trees and reference objects: One reference monument consisting of a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap stamped to indicate the corner position as follows: R.M. - S24°W, 33.36 feet - with steel sign post 0.96 feet away; P. pole - N25°W, 24.53 feet; existing R. pine 16"- N58°E, 61.28 feet; SW corner of garage
