

I, John R. A. Description of original monument and accessories and / or subsequent restoration:

Original survey by William Ives in 1848.******

B. Description of corner evidence found and / or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

I found a ½" iron rod bent over on the Westerly side of the road at the corner position. This location checks with a single proportic position between the section corners north and south.

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C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I accepted the ½" iron rod as monumenting the East quarter corner position of Section 1, T 48 N, R 48 W, and replaced it with a 3-1/4" brass capped 5/8" x 30" rebar set below road grade. I also established the following witnesses:


