Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original survey by William Ives, Deputy Surveyor, on August 11, 1848. Set post bearing trees:

8" sugar - N15°W - 13 links 16" Y. birch - S70°E - 13 links

No original evidence found.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I reestablished this corner after talking with local long time resident, Earl Jensen and Blaise Erickson, resident and land surveyor. A corner existed in this location many years ago but was destroyed due to road construction. The corner was reestablished by splitting ancient fence lines and setting the corner in the center line intersection of old trails running N-S and E-W. This position was accepted for over 40 years by local residents and the Road Commission. It is consistent with natural feature ties west and south. All other original survey evidence for this corner has been destroyed due to road construction activity.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 3/4" x 30" long rebar with a standard Bernsten 3 1/2" aluminum cap stamped: County Remonumentation; T48N, R49W; S-11; S-12; S-13; S-14; 1993; RLS 28410. Established the following bearing trees and reference objects: OFHI
