- Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - In 1848 William Burt, U.S.D.S., set a cedar post from which a 6" cedar bears N58°E 21 links and a 14" cedar S35°-15 links.
 - 1935 U.S.D.A., O.C. Schoenfeld found a 4'x4'x36" wood post at the corner location, set a tag in a 14" cedar near the corner.
 - 1966 Don Lappala, R.L.S., U.S.F.S., Suveyor found a tag on 16" cedar windfall at the corner position and left a corner monument at the location but did not monument.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a 2" diameter x 5' long concrete filled iron pipe lying on the ground with the remains of two bearing trees: 1- Found a "hacked up" 12" cedar - 10' stub; 2- 12" cedar (up-rooted) with rusty tag. This position checked with the G.L.O. call of an east bank of a ravine being 330' south of the corner and the 293.7' call north to a stream. The rusty tag we found was from a 1935 corner search as noted above. I monumented this position after reviewing Lappala's 1966 notes and checking the natural feature ties and distances north (2514.35') and south (2645.94') to monumented corner positions.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a 2" diameter x 5' long iron pipe filled with concrete. A 3 1/4" diameter brass cap is stamped: E 1/4, S-10, S-11, T49N, R46W, 1966, R.L.S. 12585, 1996, R.L.S. 28410. Established the following bearing trees and reference object:

6' steel rail with sign - S85°E - 1.96 feet 6" Y. birch - S25°E - 28.04 feet 8" sugar - S72°W - 12.60 feet

6" twin sugar - N24°W - 21.40 fect
