

Goss, in a field survey on Sept. 17, 1996 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by William A. Burt on Sept. 13,1847. Set Cedar post. Original bearing trees: 6" Maple - N 09° E- 32 links 6" W. Birch- N 650 W- 10 links.

John Garske found sq. maple post, a 10" balsam bearing tree blazed with tag from Gogebic County Forest Dept. Corner was reestablished using above and GLO calls for a stream 8 links wide 148.5 feet east and found decay Maple stump at recorded distance and bearing for original bearing tree. John Garske place a 2½" iron pipe with stamped brass cap: T49N,R48W; 1/4, S-6, S-31, 1988, RLS

28410, with the following bearing trees

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
