B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. At the apparent corner there was a $1\frac{1}{4}$ " drill steel 3 feet above ground with numerous old blazed trees facing this Could not find who set this marker. The owner of the property adjacent to the corner said it had been there a good number of years. The position agreed with the G.L.O. calls to creeks and the corner East. I accepted the drill steel as the most logical position for the corner and monumented it as shown in "C".
