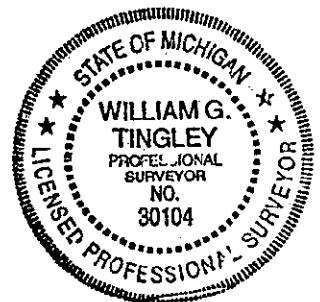

Found "T" Iron with cap .3 feet below surface
 "T" iron drove in hub of axle and hub, 1.7 feet long, 1-1/2" I.D.
 3.5 feet deep found 1-1/4" gas pipe with elbow per Hastings 1902
 Accepted as true corner

Set Remonumentation Corner and Mon Box over 1-1/4" gas pipe
