Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Corner common to Sections 5 and 8, T25N-R9W; "Wood stake witnessed by Beech 10" S12°W 9L and Hemlock 8" N23°E 39L," U.S. Survey by V.W. Caukins D.S. July, 1852. A survey by William Slawson, recorded in Liber 1, Page 6 and 7 of the Grand Traverse County Surveyors Records gave no monument type or witnesses for this corner. "Found stake" E.P. Waterman road survey dated 1915 and on file with the Grand Traverse County Planning Commission. "Dug hole $4^{\circ} \times 3^{\circ} \times 3^{\circ}$ 3', unable to find stake as described by Waterman in his 1915 survey, evidently dug out during road construction. Therefore set corner as per Waterman's October - November 1915 survey which is on file with the Grand Traverse County Court House on plans, used single proportionate method. Position fits existing North-South One-quarter line fences. Placed a 3/4" x 30" pipe in monument box," a land corner by Nelson C. Jones, Michigan Dept. of Transportation Surveyor, dated 11-7-72 and recorded in Liber 1, Page 396 of the Grand Traverse County Land Corner Records.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
D-3; ½ Corner common to Sections 5 and 8, T25N-R9W; Found a 5/8" x 30" iron bar in monument box as recorded in Liber
1, Page 396 of the Grand Traverse County Land Corners Records and is accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner. Remonumented this position with 2½" x 30" flanged bottom galvanized iron pipe with a 34" brass cap stamped GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY REMONUMENTATION, 2" below the surface of a 20'wide bituminous road (M-113.) Left 5/8' x 30" iron bar in hole and re-established monument box flush with road.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: 4 Corner common to Sections 5 and 8, T25N-R8W;

2½" x 30" flanged bottom galvanized iron pipe with 3½" brass cap stamped GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY REMONUMENTATION, 2" OF MICHIGAN below the road surface in a monument box.
