E-4: % Cor. common to Secs. 8 and 9, T25N-R9W; "Wood stake witnessed by Beech 10" N35°W 21L and Hemlock 12" S18°E 24L," U.S. Survey by V.W. Caukins D.S. July, 1852. "Set new stake original BT's good," survey by Samuel Hodgeman dated Feb. 12, 1880 and recorded in L.1, P.200 of G.T. Co. Surveyors Records. "Found iron pipe in road, no witness," Allyn survey dated Nov. 5, 1903 and recorded in L.2, P.114 & 115 of the G.T. Co. Surveyors Records. "Found iron and stone witnessed by a 5" Elm N88°W 32.7' and a 3" Sugar S44°E 32.2'," a road survey by Co. Surveyor, E.P. Waterman, dated Aug., 1914 and recorded L.12, P.171-175 of G.T. Co. Surveyors Records. "Found 14" iron pipe and added a monument box," a Land Corner Certificate by Nelson Jones, Mich. Dept. of Transportation Surveyor recorded in L.1, P.400 of the Land Cor. Records of G.T. Co.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

E-4;  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner common to Sections 8 and 9, T25N-R9W; Found 12" bolt spike inside a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" iron pipe in a monument box as recorded in Liber 1, Page 400 of the Grand Traverse County Land Corner Records and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Remonumented this position with a 2½" x 30" flanged bottom galvanized iron pipe with 3%" brass cap stamped GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY REMONUMENTATION, 2" below the surface of a 28' wide North-South bituminous road. Left bolt spike and iron pipe in bottom of hole and re-established monument box.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: E-4: 1 Corner common to Sections 8 and 9, T25N-R9W;
