- 1/4 Cor common to Secs 15 & 22, T25N-R1OW; "Beech post witnessed by a Sugar 14" N32°E 12 links and a Sugar 18" S38°W 18 links", U.S. Survey by L.S. Scranton dated August 1852. "We found the old stake 18" East of the Cor Stevens set and decided it was the old 1/4 post, all rotten. Set stone in bottom of pit 2 1/2' deep grey granite 24" x 16" x 13" and marked a "X" on top and 1/4 Sec on side with the top coming to the surface.", Survey by C.P. Tuller dated May 2, 1902 as recorded in G.T. Co. Surveyor Records. "Set 1/2" iron rod by single proportion East and West with the deflection as said corner based on occupation and use.", LCR by J.L. Wilcox recorded in L.2, Pg. 361 of G.T. Co. Land Corner Records. "Found grey granite stone with "X" on top, added railroad spike on North edge.", LCR by Robert F. Mitchell dated March 29, 1985 recorded in L.3, Pg.9 of G.T. Co. Land Corner Records. H-7)

1/4 Cor. common to Secs 15 & 22, T25N-R10W; Found a 12" x 15" x 22" light colored granite stone with an "X" on top and 1/4 Sec scribed on the side surrounded by cobblestones and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original Corner. Remonumented this position with a 2 1/2" x 30" flanged bottom galvanized iron pipe with a 3 1/4" brass cap stamped GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY REMONUMENTATION, 8" below the surface of a 30' wide East and West gravel road.
