 - 1/4 Cor common to Secs 11 & 14, T25N-R1lW; "Wood post witnessed by a Sugar 11" S80 'W 20 links and a Hemlock 15" N61'W 41 links", U.S. Survey by Alvin & Austin Burt dated May 1839. "Reset from stump of U.S. Witness, new witness is Basswood 10" S54 E 17 links and a Maple 15" N45 E 36 links", Allyn Survey dated around 1900 and the records are on file in the G.T. County Surveyor Records. "Began at Cor 14, a stake set by E.H. Allyn from the Govt Witness tree to the NW", survey by Co. Surveyor E.P. Waterman dated Nov. 1907 and on record in the G.T. County Surveyor Records. "Fd 1/2" rod in the C/L of Rahe Rd", LCR by Glenn F. DeLaMater, recorded in L.2, Pg.550 of the LCR's of G.T. County.
