Waterman dated Sept. and Oct. 1912 and recorded in the Co. Surveyors Records of Grand Traverse Co. "Fd good iron in ground", survey by C.P. Tuller dated Sept. 9, 1919. Field notes on file with Mitchell & Assoc. "Set railroad spike from iron 462.0' North and Maple witness, Waterman (1912)", Cert. of Survey by William B. County and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Remonumented this position with a 2 1/2" x 30" flanged bottom galvanized iron pipe with a 3 1/4" brass Cap stamped GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY REMONUMENTATION, 6" below the surface of the road and replaced monument box.
