A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

F-9; ½ Corner common to Sections 21 and 28, T26N-R1OW; "Wood post witnessed by a Hemlock 14" S6°E 41L and Beech 12" N19°E 12L," U.S. resurvey conducted by L.S. Stranton dated July, 1852. "Found old ½ post on North line Section 28 where we found an old Cedar about 5" in diameter marked ½ Section and previously noted by George E. Steele at least, we drove new Cedar and also an iron bolt 12" x 1½"," a survey by County Surveyor, E. P. Waterman, dated September 14, 1908 and on file in the records of the Grand Traverse County Surveyors. "Found iron" certified survey by Glenn F. DeLaMater, dated October 15, 1973, recorded in Liber 2, page 221 of certified surveys. "Found 3/4" iron pipe" A land corner record by Danny Bongiovanni dated October 21, 1981, and recorded in Liber 2, page 482 of the Land Corner Records of Grand Traverse County. "Found 3/4" iron pipe" certified boundary survey by Phillip D. Case, dated October 10, 1991.

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- F-9; ½ Corner common to Sections 21 and 28, T26N-R10W; Found 3/4" iron pipe as recorded in Liber 2, page 482 of the land corner records of Grand Traverse County. Also found 1½" x 12" iron bar and a cedar stake point as called for in E. P. Waterman survey dated September 14,1908 and accepted this position as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Remonumented this position with a 2½" x 30" flanged bottom galvanized iron pipe with 3½" brass cap stamped GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY REMONUMENTATION flush with the ground. The 3/4" iron pipe as recorded in Liber 2, page 482 of the Grand Traverse County Land Corner Records, is located North 49° West, 16.81 feet.
 - C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- F-9; & Corner common to Sections 21 and 28, T26N-R10W;

 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" flanged bottom galvanized iron pipe with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " brass cap stamped GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY REMONIMENTATION and flush with the ground.

N17°W - 10" Beech in clump - 55.48'

S88°W - 12" Maple - 60.57'

N49°W - 3/4" pipe and fences - 16.81'

N34°E - 8" White Pine - 6.17'

S61°E - 8" Oak in clump - 36.09'
