Measured E 1320'± 1' (1320-EPW) to Historic Fence Corner E, W. & N. Did not dig for stake and stone as noted by Waterman because R. Mitchell said he had dug before. Capped ½" rebar #28417 re-establishing Hodgeman & Waterman's position accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.  - Reference Point: - FND.
