Also found a 1.1'x 0.8'x 0.4' sandstone 4' W'ly that fits Batzer's survey. Waterman's notes indicate that Slawson's stone was 12' +/- S. of the E-W line he marked which would fit the correct calculated position closely. Thus I set 1/2" X 24" Rebar per standard BLM procedure & reset Found Slawson stone over top. Fits line of Slawson stones 1/4 & 1/2 mile East and Waterman distance to East closely.
