In 1971, Gourdie/Fraser finds 1-1/4" Iron pipe during survey for plat of English Woods and sets concrete monument.

In 1977, Carl Roser finds concrete monument and files Act 74 L.C.R. (Liber 2, Page 289).

3. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found concrete monument and Conservation post. No witnesses of record were found.
