All original evidence destroyed by road construction. Corner was re-established by single proportion measure midway on a line between the N.E. corner and the N.W. corner of Section 7.

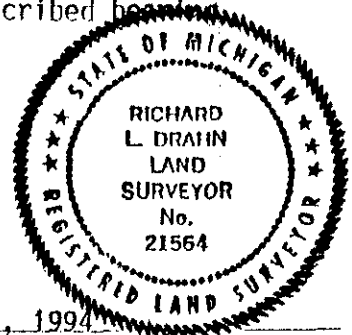

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a standard 2" diameter by 30" long split base aluminum monument with a 3 1/2" aluminum cap stamped to read: T.48N., R.37W.; 1/4; S.6, S.7; 1993; R.L.S. 21564: from which I established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees and/or reference objects:

8"	Ironwood	N.04°W.	10.13 feet
18"	Hemlock	N.59°E.	29.93 feet
8"	Sugar Maple	S.60°E.	2.28 feet

A 6' steel sign post bears: N.03°W. 1.25 feet
